
The Justice and Peace office in the diocese has just received an up-to-date list of schools in the Latin Patriarchate of Jerusalem and wonder whether your students would like to send Easter greetings cards as part of their Lenten activities.

Students in the Latin Patriarchate often feel isolated from the rest of the world. They appreciate receiving cards and Fr David Neuhaus SJ described it as "A beautiful act of solidarity".

The procedure for sending post depends on whether the school is in Israel or Palestine. The postal service in Palestine is insecure so cards need to be put into bundles and sent to the administrator in Jerusalem. Cards can be sent directly to schools in Israel.

The attachment gives clear directions on how to administer this activity.
