## MONDAY

## TUESDAY

### St Aelred of Rievaulx, Abbot

*Born in 1110, Aelred died at Rievaulx (Yorkshire)  
on this day in 1167. He is remembered for his gift  
for friendship, for his gentle and sensitive rule and  
for his spiritual writings, especially that on  
friendship.*

Entrance Antiphon:

**Upon a lofty throne, I saw a man seated, whom  
a host of angels adore, singing in unison: behold**

him, the name of whose empire is eternal.

First Reading: Hebrews 2: 5-12

*It was appropriate that God should make perfect through suffering the leader who would take them to their salvation.*

Responsorial Psalm:

**You gave your Son power over the works of your hand.**

Gospel Acclamation:

**Alleluia, Alleluia! Accept and submit to the word which has been planted in you and can save your souls. Alleluia!**

Gospel: Mark 1: 21-28

*He taught them with authority.*

Communion Antiphon:

**With you, O Lord, is the fountain of life, and in your light we see light.**

## WEDNESDAY

### St Hilary, Bishop and Doctor

*C. 315-368 was brought up as a pagan and married young. He later converted to Christianity and as Bishop of Poitiers, was a leading defender of the Church against the Arian heresy, which caused him to be exiled to Phrygia by the Arian emperor Constantius. He was declared a doctor of the Church in 1851.*

Entrance Antiphon:

**Upon a lofty throne, I saw a man seated, whom a host of angels adore, singing in unison: behold him, the name of whose empire is eternal.**

First Reading: Hebrews 2: 14-18

*It was essential that he should in this way become completely like his brothers so that he could be compassionate.*

Responsorial Psalm:

**The Lord remembers his covenant for ever.**

Gospel Acclamation:

**Alleluia, Alleluia! Let the message of Christ, in all its richness, find a home with you; through him give thanks to God the Father. Alleluia!**

Gospel: Mark 1: 29-39

*He cured many who were suffering from diseases of one kind or another.*

Communion Antiphon:

**With you, O Lord, is the fountain of life, and in your light we see light.**

## THURSDAY

### St Kentigern (Mungo)

SECONDARY PATRON OF THE ARCHDIOCESE

*Born c. 516 Kentigern was brought up in the discipline and piety of St Servanus, Abbot of Gilross and was sent to Glasgow, becoming Bishop there. Known as "mungo" (One dearly beloved) he was vigorous in his defence of the Faith against Pelagianism. He had to flee Glasgow for a time and lived with St David in Menevia. He built a monastery and school which he left in the care of St Asaph. He returned to Scotland as Bishop for the next 40 years.*

Entrance Antiphon:

**The Lord established for him a covenant of peace, and made him the prince, that he might have the dignity of the priesthood for ever.**

First Reading: 1 Samuel 1: 9-20

*The Lord was mindful of Hannah and she gave birth to Samuel.*

Responsorial Psalm:

**My heart exults in the Lord my Saviour.**

Gospel Acclamation:

**Alleluia, Alleluia! Accept and submit to the word which has been planted in you and can save your souls. Alleluia!**

Gospel: Mark 1: 21-28

*He taught them with authority*

Communion Antiphon:

**"Follow me and I will make you fishers of men." Whereupon, leaving their nets and their boat, they followed the Lord.**

## FRIDAY

### Weekday

Entrance Antiphon:

First Reading: Hebrews 4: 1-5, 11
